NJOS MEETING & TOUR ITINERARY

Saturday, June 7: Overnight flight to Shannon.

Sunday, June 8: Welcome to Ireland! After clearing immigration and customs you will meet the Long's Travel Service representative who will welcome you & direct you to the motorcoach for the transfer to the five star deluxe Dromoland Castle. There will be time to enjoy the beautiful gardens and your elegant surroundings before dinner this evening in the Castle Dining Room. **OR** go straight to the beautiful Dromoland golf course for a round before lunch! (see option on the registration form to secure a room for Saturday night, to ensure immediate check-in upon arrival at 7:00 a.m. Otherwise, guests will be able to access a "changing room" and check-in will be available early afternoon.)

Monday, June 9: After a full Irish breakfast, drive to the coast to view the dramatic Cliffs of Moher, which rise to almost 700' of sheer rock above the wild Atlantic breakers and stretch for five miles. Continue along Galway Bay into the city of Galway where you will have a brief tour of the city with time on your own for lunch and shopping. Return to the Castle in the afternoon to prepare for tonight's Medieval Banquet at Bunratty Castle.

Tuesday, June 10: choose either (1)

Golf Option: Representing the first European design by Arnold Palmer, Tralee Golf Club is one of the most spectacularly beautiful golf courses in the world. There will be transportation directly to Tralee from Dromoland today for the lucky participants and transportation back to Killarney late afternoon... or (2) **Option:** Those not playing golf will travel southwest passing the outskirts of Limerick City and stopping in the charming village of Adare, renowned for its thatched cottages, for a picture stop before continuing on to Killarney. You may want to take advantage of the Spa within the hotel or wander through the many shops and pubs before meeting your colleagues at a welcome cocktail party & dinner this evening.

Wednesday, June 11: NJOS kicks off its spring meeting this morning with buffet breakfast at 7:00 a.m. This afternoon there will be an opportunity to play golf in Killarney at historical Mahoney's Point **OR** discover the

glorious Dingle Peninsula, made famous by David Lean's movie, "Ryan's Daughter". Drive along the south shore and stop to admire views of heathery mountains, sandy stretches of beach and rocky headlands. Pause in Dingle town to try the local fare for dinner (on own) before returning to Killarney.

Thursday, June 12: NJOS meeting this morning with buffet breakfast at 7:00 a.m. The annual NJOS golf tournament takes place this afternoon in Killarney at the lakeside Killeen Course, the venue for past Irish Opens and the Curtis Cup. Those not playing golf today may take the jaunting cart out to the 19th century Muckross House & Gardens situated in the Killarney National Park overlooking the lower lake.

Friday, June 13: Today you're on your own and can take advantage of two different sightseeing options offered: *Travel to County Cork and the village of Blarney* where you have the opportunity to kiss the famous stone located in the ramparts of Blarney Castle to receive the "gift of eloquence". Take some time to walk through the gardens, around the village green or shop at the famous Blarney Woollen Mills, renowned for their quality Irish merchandise. **OR** take the second bus to the *Ring of Kerry*, one of Ireland's most popular scenic areas with Ireland's highest

mountains on one side and a varied Atlantic coastline on the other. As you drive, every turn will reveal new vistas of mountains, cliffs and beaches and there will be plenty of photo stops. Everyone will return to Killarney in the late afternoon with the remainder of the day at leisure to explore some of Killarney's many pubs that feature live music.

Saturday, June 14: NJOS meeting this morning begins at 7:00 a.m. with buffet breakfast. The remainder of the day is free for relaxing. Our farewell dinner this evening will be held at a local establishment with entertainment. The perfect ending to a wonderful week!
